Work health and safety policy



Shared Hope Training Pty Ltd is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy workplace for all workers (including contractors and volunteers) as well as students, visitors and members of the public. Hazards and risks to health and safety will be eliminated or minimised, as far as is reasonably practicable.

- Follow safe work procedures, instructions and rules
- Participate in safety training
- Report health and safety hazards
- Report all injuries and incidents
- Use safety equipment and personal protective equipment as instructed

Our goal is to provide a safe and healthy work environment that is free from workplace injury and illness. This will only be achieved through the participation, co-operation and commitment of everyone in the workplace or training room/s.

We believe that the well-being of people employed at work, or people affected by our work, or even students involved in our training courses is a priority and must be considered during all work/ learning tasks performed on our behalf.

People are our most important asset and work health and safety is everyone's responsibility. The safety of the public is given equal priority to that of our workers.

The objectives of this policy are to, as far as reasonably practicable:

- achieve a safe and incident free workplace / training room/s
- consider WHS in project planning and work / learning activities
- involve employees and subcontractors in the decision-making process through regular communication and consultation



- ensure employees and subcontractors identify and control risks in the workplace
- monitor and review the elimination or control of potential risks
- enhance employees' WHS knowledge through a program of education and training

The success of our WHS management depends on:

- the commitment of all persons to achieving the policy objectives
- planning work activities, with due consideration given to WHS
- undertaking the risk management process in an effective manner
- communication and consultation between our workers and subcontractors.
